

How to Embed Google Docs, PDFs to WordPress Posts & Pages

Whether you have a blog on **WordPress.com** or on self hosted WordPress (i.e. **WordPress.org**), embedding Google Docs to WordPress page or post possible. It's easy.

Here in this post, I will show you the methods for both WordPress.com and WordPress.org

Let's get started.

Embedding Google Docs To WordPress.org

Easily embed the Google Docs PDFs to your WordPress website (in post or pages) with [Google Docs Embedder WordPress plugin](#). The plugin helps you to embed the Google documents, PDFs to your website without using flash or using any PDF browser plugin.

Also, you can adjust the height and width of the PDFs embedded to your site from the general setting options..

Most importantly you can prevent the download of your PDFs from the website by using the profile options there in the plugin.

Adding the Google Docs Embedder WP Plugin

First you will need to install the plugin to your WordPress Dashboard.

To do this, go to your WordPress Dashboard >> Plugins >> Add New

Type keyword "Google Docs Embedder" in search box. Once you see the plugin there, just install and activate it.

Embedding Google Docs to WordPress.com

Go to Google Drive

Pick your document

Go to File >> Click Publish to the web >> Automatically republish after the changes made.

Hit Publish >> Okay >> Get the embed code and copy it.

Use that embed code in your WordPress blog.

Go to your WordPress Dashboard.

Click on pages.

Select your page. Go to Text option.

Paste the embed code and hit publish.
